

## VAT Exemption Form

You will not have to pay VAT if you can declare that you are chronically sick or disabled. You do not have to be registered disabled to claim relief from VAT but the nature of your illness or disablement must be specified. If you are in any doubt as to whether you are eligible to receive goods or services zero-rated for VAT you should consult your local VAT office before signing the declaration. There are severe penalties for anyone who makes use of a document which they know to be false for the purpose of obtaining VAT relief.
